Now is the time for us to move towards restoring and preserving habitat to improve wildlife health. Open spaces, grasslands, and riparian areas must be preserved in order for our future generations to enjoy elk and other wildlife. With this in mind, the AES has raised over \$4,000,000 for Arizona's elk herd management, wildlife habitat improvements and protection and our Youth Programs.



Through the generosity of our donors, sponsors and the unselfish donation of time by our dedicated volunteers, the AES, with matching funds, has funded and completed projects and programs totaling over \$10 million dollars throughout Arizona. Recent programs funded include:

- The Burro Creek, Big Lake and Buck Springs Allotment retirement and realignment, conserving over 100,000 acres for wildlife
- The AZGFD annual Landowner Stewardship Program
- Tusayan pipeline and Moqui water catchments in Unit 9
- 4 Bar Mesa browse release and juniper thinning
- Numerous new water catchments and dirt tank cleanouts
- Cherry Creek 45,000 acre prescribed burns in Unit 23
- Chitty/Pigeon Ecosystem Restoration
- Ohaco & Atascacita Spring grassland restorations
- High Point Well pipeline
- Various habitat restoration projects including pinon-juniper thinning, elk surveys, controlled burns and restorations of meadows

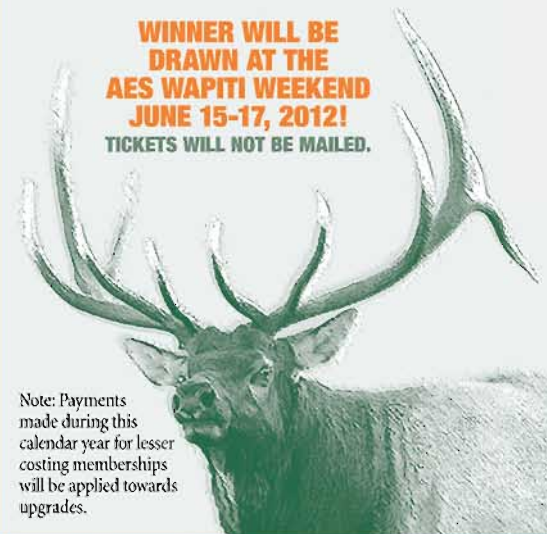
