Our volunteers haul over 500,000 gallons of water yearly to remote wildlife drinkers.
- 4. **Heroes Rising Outdoors:** Heroes Rising Outdoors provides outdoor experiences to veterans who have suffered physical or emotional injuries while serving our country. This program helps participants heal and build camaraderie with other veterans. Arizona Elk Society collaborates with local guides, outfitters and volunteers to provide a top-notch hunting experience, and all costs associated with the hunt are paid by the program. HRO also provides opportunities for veterans and their families to experience the outdoors, such as equine therapy, fly-fishing and bass fishing trips, and volunteerism.
